Nature of Support

Objectives in spending PPG:

To support PPG children to achieve age expected attainment at the end of the year and to support all PPG pupils to make good progress in line with their peers. We will target this through:

A PPG Learning Plan or ILP if SEND to target specific learning needs.

First quality teaching in class.

Specific one-to-one support/small group work for phonics/reading and maths.

Specific one to one/small group support for speech, language & communication.

Small group work on SEMH needs

One-to-one/small group support work with First Class at Numbers Teaching Assistant.

One to one adult time in class to help support learning.

Provision of yoga class during school day weekly - this is funded through our Sports Premium

We have a PPG Teaching assistant for 18.33 hours per week to support some of the above - £7374

Additional PPG teaching assistant for 15 hours per week - £5560

Many groups outlined above are supported through classroom teaching assistants, our Inclusion Manager or the Headteacher.
